

Robbers kill two traders in Borno

TRAGEDY struck last weekened in Malam Fatori area of Abadam local government area of Borno State where armed robbers killed two traders returning from a market.

The robbers also carted away property worth thousands of naira during the incident made available to *Daily Champion* indicated that the Secretary of the Council, Alhaji Shettima Kachalla, sympathized with the family of the deceased and urged security operatives in the area to be more vigilant at checking criminal activities within the council and its environs.

Meanwhile, determined to rid the notorious Bama - Gwoza highway in the state of armed bandits, the police and members of National Union of Road Transport Workers (NURTW) in the area have embarked on the clearing of bushes around the road paths for clearer visibility.

With the joint collaboration, it is expected that motorists plying the highway would be able spot from afar, any criminal activity and report same to the authorities for proper action.

The divisional police officer in Gwoza local government area, Alhaji Alkali, who flagged off the exercise around Pulka - Bama area commended the council authority for rendering assistance in the clearing exercise.

According to him, with a clearer view, security personnels keeping watch on the black spots on the road would no longer have difficulty tracking the robbers in the bush.
