Trouble started when Ganiyu challenged his colleague over the money said to have been paid to them by their client.


An eyewitness told Daily Champion that both men who worked at the place as 'casual workers' had a minor misunderstanding over who should get the lion share of the money.

He added that the money was not part of the total money charged by the duo but extra money their client added to them as a result of satisfaction of job well done.

slumped and became
unconscious. He was

hospital where he later died.

Investigating Police

Officer, at the homicide section of State Criminal Investigating Department (SCID) Panti, Yaba (name

witheld) said the corpse of Ganiyu has been deposited in the morgue for autopsy.

He said "On July 27

2006 at about 1pm, there was a report at SCID, that one Kolawole Kazeem Musa of Naval Dock Yard base, Texaco and Ganiyu engaged themselves in a fist blows over the sharing of payment of N700. Ganiyu slumped and was rushed to the hospital for treatment where he later gave up."

At SCID cell, Musa

blamed his action on the devil, noting that "it was the devil's work, I love him, and I didn't mean to

hit him".
