

Rivers police arrest 2 suspected cultists

RIVERS State Police Command on Wednesday arrested two suspected cultists allegedly linked to the killing of four innocent youths at Njemanze Waterfront, Port Harcourt.

Recovered from the suspected cultists, who gave their names as Chubo Dikibo and Labomie Agborubere were two American pistols numbers 16-11929 and 9465, locally made guns, knives and charms.

Daily Champion learnt that the suspects were nabbed during a shoot-out between them and police at Bille Waterfront in Port Harcourt.

They are currently assisting police in the state capital at the

State Criminal and Investigation Department (SCID) with relevant information on criminal acts in Port Harcourt.

Contacted Rivers State Commissioner of Police, Mr. Samuel Adetuyi confirmed the arrest noting that the hoodlums would be properly investigated and prosecuted accordingly. Adetuyi who insisted on community policing said, all hands must be on deck in the war against criminality in the state.

He solicited for public co-operation in curbing crimes, just as he appealed to the residents to always report suspected criminals to the police for possible arrest. The Police Commissioner said that, the command was combat ready to fight crimes in the state, particularly armed robbery.
