

# LASTMA official dies in auto crash

A hit and run driver yesterday ran over an official of the Lagos State Traffic Management Authority (LASTMA) at Ijeshatedo along Oshodi-Apapa expressway

The deceased, Mrs Aminat adenirabn, according to *Daily Champion* finding was killed at the spot while waiting for a vehicle that would convey her to office at the state secretariat,

Alausa, Ikeja.

Eyewitness account said late Mrs. Adeniran slump and died immediately she was hit before sympathizers could come to her aid, just as the driver whose identity could not be ascertained drove off in anxiety.

The Chief Executive Officer of LASTMA, Mr. young Arebamen confirmed the tragedy saying that Aminat died on the spot because of severe injuries she sustained in the accident."

He, however, condemned the gruesome murder of the official who he described as a diligent and hardworking officer who put in her best to reduce the sufferings of motorists in the state.

Arebamen appealed to the public especially the eyewitnesses to the sad occurrence to avail his authority with information that can lead to the arrest of the culprit.

Meanwhile, the remains of the LASTMA official had been deposited at the General Hospital, Ikeja for autopsy, after which the authority's chieftain said she would be buried with full honours.
