

# Police probe death of house wife

**P**OLICE detectives from State Criminal Investigative Department (SCID) Panti, Yaba are investigating the circumstances leading to stabbing to death of one Mrs Christine Amadi, a resident of Block 35 Flat 8, LSDPF Estate, Ebute Metta area of Lagos State by one Abdulkadir Isa, a neighbour living at Block 23, Flat 2.

The incident happened just as a ghastly motor accident involving a Mercedes Benz car with registration number AY 170 AB driven by one Mr Teslim Shoyemi ran over three pedestrians living one of the victims dead and the two others hospitalised.

Eye witness said Abdulkadir stabbed his victim on the throat

during an argument which ensued between them. Mrs Amadi died before help could come her way. The incident which occurred at about 8.30 pm on October 30, has left the shocked neighbourhood and the family of the deceased in mourning.

According to Police Public Relations Officer, Mr Olubode Ojajuni, a Deputy Superintendent of Police, police men from Panti have removed the body of the deceased to a public mortuary for autopsy while investigation into the murder case continues.

The ghastly accident which occurred along Awolowo Way, Ikeja, at about 8.000 am according to reports, left one Alima dead while the two unidentified victims are still hospitalised.

Meanwhile, a

member of a gang of armed bandits terrorising Okokomaiko area Friday Samuel has been arrested. The men of the underworld, were said to be operating on a motorcycle at Afromedia Bus Stop along a Badagry Expressway at about 10 pm when policemen from Okokomaiko Police Station swooped on them. While other members of the gang took to their heels, Samuel was not as lucky.

Meanwhile, Samuel is presently helping the police in their attempt to arrest other members of the gang while exhibits recovered from him have been handed over to State CID Panti, Yaba.

Confirming the stories, Ojajuni said police is currently investigating the incidents.
