

POLICEMEN at Orile and Okota, respectively are investigating the death of a security man attached to a commercial bank (nameswitheld) in Orile as well as the mysterious death of a chorister at a Pentecostal Church at Okota, Lagos.

Daily Champion gathered that the security guard, identified as Oseni Adamu was found dead near airconditioners, close to the banking hall.

Our correspondent learnt that the deceased left his colleagues at the gate to

urinate at the back of the bank only to be found dead at the point later.

An eyewitness said the deceased did not complain of any ill-health before his death, stressing that there was nothing to suggest that he was ill.

However, police preliminary investigation said no foul play was suspected in the manner and way of death.

Also the mysterious death of a chorister with a Pentecostal Church at Ali Dada street, Ago palace Okota, identified as Timothy is also a puzzle before the police in the area.

Eyewitness said the choirister was attempting to switch on electrical appliances in the church before he slumped and died.

He was said to have come for a song rehearsal in the church when the incident occurred.

According to our source, the deceased was found dead near the church musical instrument.

But police preliminary report said that the victim was suspected to have been electrocuted.

Confirming the above, command's spokesman, Mr. Olubode Ojajuni said police have commenced investigation into the matter.

According to him, the victim died instantly, stressing that their bodies have been deposited in public mortuaries for autopsies.

He said "there was a report at Orile police station that one Oseni, a security man attached to a commercial bank, Orile Iganmu branch left his mates to go and take his bathe at the back but was found dead near air conditioner at the bank premises, no foul play suspected."
