3 killed in political clash

Three people were killed and many injured in a violent clash between two militant groups of political thugs in Ngomari Costain in Jere local government area of Borno State last Thursday.

The News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) reports that trouble started about 2 p.m. when the two groups clashed, using dangerous weapons such as machetes and knives.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Alhaji Bashir Umar, said the people killed in the fracas were burnt beyond recognition before the arrival of policemen at the scene of the incident.

He said that about 10 suspects had been arrested, while investigations into the matter had since commenced.

Bashir, however, said that the cause of the clash was yet to be ascertained.

NAN recalls that last week, a retired soldier, an aged woman and her 18 year-old son were murdered in the Kululuri are the bullet by yet-to-be identified.
