

Doctor's murder: FMC Owerri staff go spiritual

FOLLOWING the gruesome murder of one of the senior medical officers of the Federal Medical Centre Owerri, Dr. Godfrey Duruewuru by unknown assassins, both the doctors and nurses and other workers of the hospital have reacted sadly and resorted to prayers to seek divine intervention into the matter.

Management of the hospital had to invite some men of God who conducted an open air prayers on Friday under the scorching harmattan sun to cry

to God over the unparalleled, inhuman treatment metted on their respected colleague.

However, as a follow up, the management have declared three days of fasting and mourning to seek divine vengeance.

Daily Champion gathered that the deceased, who was a consultant physician from Isu LGA, Imo State according to fellow workers, was humble, truthful, never played with his job; also treated his patients kindly.

The workers who spoke on

the basis of anonymity, called on the Imo State police command to endeavour to fish out the killers of the physician.

It would be recalled that the deceased, who was murdered last week in his Orji Owerri residence under very gruesome circumstances, caused his fellow physicians in the hospital to protest to the Imo State police command; and consequently the Imo State executive council, was summoned to deliberate on the matter.
