TRAGEDY struck on the I notorious Third Mainland Bridge in Lagos, yesterday, leaving a pregnant woman and

Death came the way of the commuters when a Mercedes Benz truck-bruck popularly known as Molue in Lagos, in which they were travelling out of Lagos Island, crashed into a

luxury car on losing control.

As at press time last night, Lagos police spokesman, Olubode Ojajuni, told Daily Champion that he could not confirm a casualty figure.

The accident, which happened
