

# Police kill 3 suspected robbers in Rivers

The suspected hoodlums who snatched a Nokia hand set and the sum of N4000 cash from their victims were said to be two males and a woman.

The command which described the suspects as deadly and notorious said, they were shot death during an exchange of fire by the police on Tuesday along the stadium road in the city.

According to the command, the police recovered one motorcycle with registration

number QT 237 PHC, a Nokia hand set and the sum of N44,000 naira only from the suspects.

Other items recovered from the robbers included a revolver pistol, live ammunitions and sharp objects.

Commenting on the incident, Police Public Relations Officer, Rivers State Police command, Mr Ireju Barasua, (DSP) while confirming the killing described the robbers as wicked and deadly, just as she said the suspects had been terrorizing the residents of Elekahia community.

Barasua also disclosed that, the command was battle ready to make Port Harcourt free from crimes and criminalities, particularly this period of elections in the state.

The PPRO who also appealed to the public to always report crimes and criminalities to the police called on the people to assist the command with relevant and genuine information on robbers so as to effectively effect arrest and possibly prosecute them.

The police image maker also warned youths to desist from electoral malpractices during elections.
