

5 killed in auto crash

NO fewer than five people died yesterday in Lagos when a trailer with registration number Lagos XL 677 KSF with full load of groundnut and corn rammed into median demarcating the Lagos-Ibadan Express way at the old toll gate axis of the road.

This is as four other persons lost their lives at the Enugu Water Front area of Port Harcourt, Rivers State, Wednesday night due to alleged fume from a generator.

The Lagos accident, which occurred around 7.30 am our correspondent gathered might have been as a result of loss of control by the truck's driver alleged to be asleep when the tragedy occurred.

Our correspondent further gathered that the only survivor the "motor boy" who on seeing the debris, fainted before being revived by sympathizers that the driver who also died on the spot was coming from Kano state, but stopped at Ojo Oba, Iwo in Osun state to pick passengers.
