

Woman arrested for son's death

A 19-year-old housewife, Wasiu Opeyemi is now cooling off in the police net after confessing of her involvement in the mysterious death of her 18-month-old son, Abdullahi, who was said to have been used for money ritual by a fake prophet.

Narrating her encounter with the fake prophet yesterday in Ado-Ekiti, Ekiti State capital, Opeyemi said she was deluded by the prophet into the deal with the promise of N500,000 if he could produce the manhood for money ritual.

The woman, being held at the police post in the palace of Ewi of Ado-Ekiti yesterday confessed that she first objected to the offer but later got convinced when the prophet told her that neither her one-year-old son nor her husband would be harmed.

Opeyemi narrated how she had solely attended the mushroom church of the "prophet" situated right in the heart of the bush around the palm plantation of the ministry of agriculture, popularly called Agric Olope Ajilosun area in Ado Ekiti, where they had sex severally on bare ground.

She claimed that at the outset, she informed her husband about her affair with the prophet, which she said her husband was favourably disposed to since he was said to be a prophet of God, but confessed to journalists that she had all the while hidden the rest of her affair with the prophet from her husband when things started taking on horrendous dimension.

According to her "The last time I got to the prophet, I was pressurized by the man to take an oath with him that I would not bring my son to his church again which I obliged."
