

Rivers: 3 robbers drown in borrow pit

FOUR notorious armed robbers in port Harcourt city on Sunday night met their Waterloo as three of the gangs got drowned in a borrow pit filled with stagnant water while the vigilante group hacked down the later.

The suspected criminals who stormed the Rumuolumeni community near the Nigeria Navy Pathfinder base in the state capital to loot shops but luck ran out of the four man gang as they all perished before the next day morning.

One of the suspected robbers was executed through jungle justice by the angry mobs of the community as the three others attempted escaping arrest before jumping into a borrow pits filled with waterlogged.

Our correspondent also reports that the fourth robber was killed with a machete as

he was butchered beyond recognition by the youths of the village.

The four man robbers who invaded the community on the Sunday evening to loot property in a shops were heavily armed with dangerous weapons even as they met their untimely death living their arms behind.

One of the suspected robbers was hacked down in the front of a popular joint called the Jaros base in the community located twenty minutes from the garden city.

Orient Express also gathered that the drowned robbers do not know the terrain in the community where they invaded to loots peoples property as they unknowingly jumped into a pool to escape arrest by the mobs of the community.

Our correspondent gathered that since the cults attacked on the community months ago,

the villagers formed a vibrant vigilante groups to ward off robbers and secret cults activities in the area.

The yet to be identified robbers, our reporter gathered were in their early thirties in age as most of them were wearing jeans trousers and black shirts as their corpses float on the pool of water begging for burial and removal from the members of the public.

When visited the ugly scene, the corpses of the robbers and the remains of the macheted one were all laying unclaimed by the public even as the police confirmed the incident.

Contacted for comment on the killing of the notorious robbers, the Divisional Police Unit in the area confirmed the incident as the police is in collaboration with the community to sanitized the community from crimes and all manners of cultism.

He lauded the vigilante group for the act of bravery even as all the arms from the robbers were recovered by the police.
