

2 killed in Kano LG poll

AT least two people were killed in Kano amid violence and kidnapping which characterized the local government elections conducted yesterday throughout the state.

Kano State police commissioner, Alhaji Muhammed Aminu Yusuf, who confirmed the development told reporters that supporters of the political parties were engaged in violent attacks against themselves.

According to him, it was as a result of such attacks that the two people were killed.

Meanwhile violence, delay in the distribution of the electoral materials and rigging were said to have characterized yesterday's election in Kano.

Our correspondent in Kano gathered that the ruling party in the state, All Nigeria Peoples Party (ANPP) was leading in all the areas visited.
