

Brother kills sibling over ₦30,000

A 32 year old man has killed his younger brother over a paltry sum of N30,000 at Onititi Village in Atan liebu, Ogun State.

He claimed to have killed his brother under the strong influence of a spell (known as Edi in Yorubaland) cast on him by his enemies.

The murderer, one Sina Oyawole, a cocoa farmer who confessed to the crime was paraded at Eleweran police headquarter along with 17 others, including two suspected armed robbers who disguised as military men by wearing uniforms to rob especially passengers of commercial luxury buses.

Admitting to the crime in a chat

with *Saturday Champion*, Oyawole said truly he killed his younger brother, Sina following a bloody clash over his failure to fulfill the sum of N30,000 he promised the deceased, contrary to police report that he was owing him the sum of money.

Oyawole said he inflicted several machet cut, which sent Sina to the world beyond during a bloody clash, which ensued at their farm at Onititi village, Atan, last Sunday.

Narrating what led to the incident, Oyawole said he invited his late brother who was a commercial driver in Lagos to join him in his cocoa business at his farm at Onititi village.

He stated that his brother's

invitation was sequel to his series of complaints that business was dull for him in Lagos.

Oyawole stressed that on his brother's arrival, he promised to empower him with a mobilization of N30,000.00 to start his Cocoa business.

He informed that trouble started after two years when his brother began to suspect that he (Sina) was playing a fast one on him and as such would not give him (Niyi) the money until he employs force.

According to him, the suspicion degenerated to several row, which peaked last Sunday with a bloody clash following his brother's insistence to collect the N30,000 "do or die," while they were at their cocoa farm at Onititi village.
