

# ... Another 3 die in Warri

THREE persons were last Saturday killed in a road accident in Warri, Delta State.

The accident which involved a Jeep with registration number, Abuja, EC 380 ABC occurred at about 10:00 pm on the busy Nigeria Ports Authority (NPA) expressway.

Our Correspondent gathered that the jeep which was coming from the Warri Port skidded off the expressway and rammed into the new fence wall belonging to the Nigeria Navy opposite the entrance to the Army barracks, Effurun.

Sources told our

correspondent yesterday at about 10:30am, that the owner of the Jeep who was driving when the accident happened lost control soon after he passed the junction to the Army Barracks.

According to our Sources, in the process, the driver now receiving medical attention in a private Clinic in Warri rammed into the fence of the plot of land where it later sommasaulted several times before it came to a halt.

The owner of the jeep said to be on top speed survived the accident, thanks to the car's air bags.

But the other three

occupants, including a lady were not that lucky as they died on the spot.

It was gathered that the jeep driver was the employer of the two other male passengers, while the female was offered a lift before the accident.

At the scene yesterday, our correspondent saw the mangled jeep that was later taken away at about 11:00am by Policemen from the Ekpan Police in Uvwie Local government Area of Delta State.

The bodies of the accident victims were seen at the Warri central hospital when our correspondent visited at about 11:50am yesterday.
