

Divers recover 20 corpses of militants from Bonny River

RESCUERS today picked 20 bodies of suspected militants killed in fighting with members of the military Joint Task Force on Bonny River on Friday.

JTF spokesman, Lt-Col. Sagir Musa, said that three boats belonging to the militants were destroyed in the clash.

Residents of Bonny watched with shock as the bodies were picked from the river.

Heavily armed military personnel were patrolling the river yesterday.

Musa said that the task force also recovered four bodies and AK 47 rifles after yesterday's attack
