

# Man kills prostitute over condom

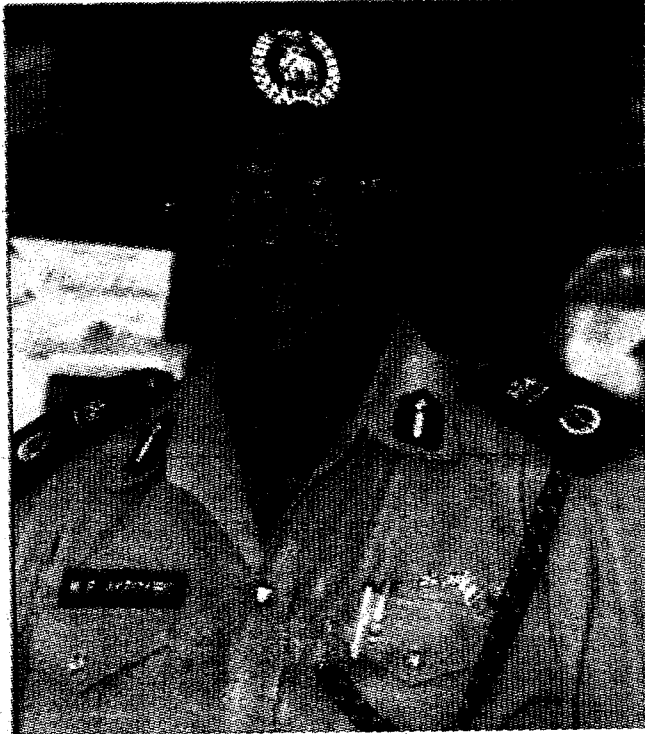
HOMICIDE detectives from State Criminal Investigations Department (SCID), Pantli Yaba, Lagos have begun manhunt of middle aged man who allegedly killed a prostitute after making love with her over burst condom.

*Daily Champion* learnt that the prostitute, simply identified as Titi had purportedly confronted his lover bird over the burst condom, insisting that the man should pay her extra money to compensate her for making love in an unsafe manner.

But the man was said to have refused arguing that he was not responsible for the burst condom.

Eyewitness at the brothel, located along railway line Oto, Oyingbo Lagos said the deceased insisted that the man pay her extra N500 and physically assaulted him resulting in a fistcuf.

The witness who pleaded for anonymity said the "male prostitute", apparently, attempting to free himself kicked the lady with his leg but she allegedly hooked onto him. The randy man in a bid to

escape stabbed the girl.

"Immediately, he stabbed her with a bottle, he took to his heels and nobody knew his destination. Other commercial sex workers attempted to prevent him from escaping but he ran faster".

Reacting to it, police spokesman Mr. Frank Mba who declined to comment on the cause of the argument between them said "although the male customer has not been nabbed, three persons believed to have played vital roles have been

arrested in connection with the death".

The deputy superintendent of Police (DSP) also said "I don't know whether the lady died over condom issue but I know the lady died during scuffle that ensued between them".

He however said preliminary investigations revealed that the prostitute was stabbed to death by yet to be apprehended suspect.

According to him "On August 26 2008, at about 0330hrs, Policemen attached to Denton Police Station received the report that one Blessing a.k.a Titi who was a commercial sex worker at a brothel was stabbed to death by a male customer".

In a related development a middle aged man who attempted steal iron rod at Ibesha town Ikorodu Lagos, was inflicted said policemen visited the scene and removed the corpse for autopsy.

He said the corpses of the two victims have been deposited at a public mortuaries.

## Security guides

9. Provide adequate security for cash in transit, including the use of police escort.
