

# Artistes protest killing of mum, baby in Lagos

OVER 100 artistes in Lagos state yesterday stormed the state secretariat, Alausa Ikeja, protesting the recent killing of a five-month old baby and his mother by armed robbers, attributing it to the poor security network in the state.

Also, about 200 concerned youths, women and political leaders in Eti-Osa local government area of the state invaded the state House of

Assembly (LAHA), pledging their solidarity for the member representing the area, Hon. Kolapo Akorede, who was recently accused of slapping a female banker during transaction.

The artistes who wore black tee-shirts arrived the secretariat at about 11am through Efe Omorogbe lamented the state of security in the state as deteriorating on a daily basis, recalling amidst tears the

gruesome murder of one Mrs. Adeyinka Kingsley James and her five-month old baby penultimate Sunday at about 6:pm around Omole, Ogba, Ikeja.

According to him, "About 6pm two Sundays ago at Big Treat, Omole; Dorcas and her baby who was sucking breast were shot by armed robbers with bullets lodged in the baby's head," adding, "the security situation had deteriorated to the extent that we can't go to sleep; robbers are getting more and more daring.
