

MOSOP accuses Ateke Tom over death of Ogoni youths

THE Movement for the Survival of the Ogoni People (MOSOP), has condemned the killing of two Ogoni sons by suspected gunmen who attacked the youths at Baranyonwa Dere in Gokana Local Government Area of Rivers State.

The MOSOP statement also accused the leader of the Niger Delta vigilante group, Mr. Ateke Tom of being responsible for the killing of the Ogoni youths.

According to the MOSOP, "We were further told that the hoodlums were suspected

to be members of Ateke Tom's cult gang, Niger Delta Vigilante".

MOSOP also described the attack as heinous crime as the incident led to the murder of two sons of Ogoni, Mr. Burabari Kpenu and Nenniibarini Naanee from Kegbara Dere and Baranyonwa Dere respectively.

The group in a statement signed by its information officer, Mr. Bara-ara Kpalap and made to *Saturday Champion* in the state capital said other youths were also confirmed to have sustained serious gunshot injuries and are receiving treatments.
