T least seven persons, Aincluding three soldiers have been killed, when suspected militants reportedly attacked the boat in which they were travelling in, on Nembe waterways in Nembe Local Government area of Bayelsa state vesterday.

Sunday Champion leant that the remains of the soldiers and other passengers killed on board the speed boat are yet to be located, although more operatives of the Joint Military Task force (JTF) have been drafted to the spot, along with local divers.
