Nigeria: Police Kill Four Robbery Suspects in Borno

BORNO State Police Command and some traditional hunters yesterday killed four

suspected armed robbers, while nabbing 11 suspects at Kirnawa village, Marte Local Government Area.

Parading the suspects at the police headquarters Maiduguri, the State Commissioner of Police Mr. Mohammed Sambo said the police from Marte division in conjunction with local hunters of Sarkin Yakin Adamawa led by Bukar Jimeta gunned down the four suspects along Marte - Manguno road, adding that three AK 47 rifles, one pistol 287 live ammunitions, 14 AK 47 rifles, one military cap, two mobiles handsets, five CD plates and N14,205.

Sambo also noted that on September 17, 2008, another armed bandits numbering about four armed with dane guns, bow and arrows attacked some motorists along Gowo-Bensheik road.

He explained that luck ran out of the bandits as a vililante group escorting the vehicle opened fire on the bandits in which one of them escaped with bullet wounds. Ads by Google

He also stated that, the injured bandit was taken to Benisheik general hospital for treatment by one Mallam Damdu Fanname, and Bulama Kunuri. The suspect was later identified as Kyari Kunduri.

He also added that the suspect, Kunduri later made a confessional statement that himself, Musa Goni and Kanembu Kunduri went out on robbery and they used a Toyota pick up with registration number XA 527 KGG.
