How man kills wife over N60

to a nearby chair and left to work. It was when I was at my work place that somebody called me and said my wife was unconscious."

The man who is popularly known

as 'Jon Kwango' said that he never believed that the 'light blow' could cause the death of his wife.

Lamenting on what he described as ill-luck the 42- year-old-man

traced how destiny has never been fair to him. According to him, his first wife died during child birth and several other woes had befallen on him.

"I am cursed in life. Nothing works for me. My first wife died during child birth and now my wife has died in this way. I did not learn any trade. I have no good job, I only managed any how work. Something is pushing me. If I see money now, I won't rest until it is finished. At that time people, including my in-law will be hailing me, calling me 'Jon Kwango', Jon Kwango etc but when the money vanishes my eyes will clear."

Speaking with Daily Champion at Ikeja the suspect said that God designed to take her life in that form. "I am not afraid, if police want to kill me, let them kill me, after all, I am no more useful on this earth. If they kill me, the curse will go. My wife was a pneumonic patient."
