

A GHASTLY motor accident along Ilorin-Egbe road last Saturday has sent four persons to an early grave.

The auto crash, which occurred about 11.30am on that fateful day, according to an eyewitness account was said to have been caused by head-on collision between two 18-seater Mazda buses coming from Egbe and Ilorin, Kogi and Kwara states respectively.

An eyewitness at the scene of the accident said that the two drivers of the commuter buses died immediately while two others died while being taken to the hospital.

gathered that one of the buses moving at neck breaking speed from Ilorin allegedly tried to over take a trailer but rammed into the oncoming bus from Egbe, thus crushing the two buses beyond repair.

A source at the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC), Omu-Aran command told *Daily Champion* that the driver apparently

trying to avoid a pothole swerved to the lane of the one coming from Egbe, Kogi state leading to the collision.

The source, however, added that two dead bodies of the drivers were recovered from the scene of the wreckage, through the intervention of some military and policemen near the area.

He added that some of the critically wounded victims of

the road mishap had been rushed to the hospital, while the bodies of the dead ones had been deposited at the Offa mortuary.

The source enjoined motorists to make care and patience their watchwords while on wheel especially during this ember month.

Penultimate weekend, about four people also lost their lives to accident along the same Ilorin-Egbe road.
