

80-year-old man murdered in Delta

AN Octogenarian, Pa Andrew Numbi, was allegedly murdered at Umuachi-Afor village, near Kwale in Ndokwa West Local Government Area of Delta.

The Police Command's Public Relations Officer (PPRO) in Delta Charles Muka confirmed the incident on Friday in Asaba in interview with the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN).

Muka said one Joy

Numbi reported to the police on Jan. 22 that one Isaac Obi allegedly murdered the 80 year old man for an unknown reason.

He said the victim was rushed to the Kwale General Hospital in Delta, where he died on Feb. 3, as a result of a deep cut on his head.

Muka also said the suspect had been arrested and arraigned before the Ashaka Magistrate's Court in the Ndokwa West Local Government Area of Delta.

In another development, two bag snatchers operating on a motorcycle with registration number QJ 458 ENU have been arrested by the police in Asaba.

According to a police source, the suspects snatched a bag containing GSM recharge cards of various networks and other valuable items from a lady, near the Mammy Market in Asaba.

The source said luck ran out on the suspects as they were caught by passers-by, who set the motorcycle ablaze and were about lynching the suspects, when the police intervened.

Muka also confirmed the incident and said the two suspects were in police custody.
