

Eid-el Maulud tragedy: Undergraduate drowns at hotel

POLICE detectives in Lagos are investigating the circumstances surrounding the drowning of an undergraduate of one of the higher institutions in Lagos, Yakubu Ibrahim at Ikeja Airport hotel, on Monday.

Daily Champion gathered that the deceased accompanied his friends to the pool as a way of celebrating the last Eid-el maulud but got drowned while swimming

in the pool.

A police source said the Commissioner of police, Mr. Marvel Akpoyibo has directed the Ikeja police division to investigate the circumstances that led to the death.

As at press time the autopsy result was been awaited to enable police know the next line of action(s).

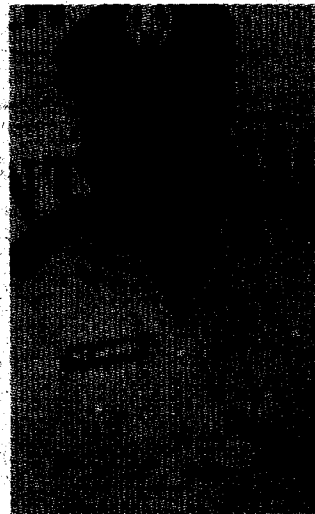
Eyewitness told Daily Champion that Ibrahim died on his way to a nearby hospital.

The witness who pleaded for anonymity said Ibrahim's case was

one of such incidents in the place. He said police investigation would determine cause of death.

Confirming the incident, Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), in the State, Mr. Frank Mba, said Policemen from Ikeja police station had visited the scene and moved the deceased to a public mortuary for autopsy.

The Superintendent of Police (SP) said investigations have begun to unravel the cause of his death.
