Osogbo court remands 2 women for murder

An Osogbo Magistrate 's Court has remanded two women, Kate Ajaka, 30, and Monsurat Fatai, 34, in prison custody for allegedly killing another woman, Odunola Olaniyi.

The police prosecutor, Mr. Joshua Oladoye, told the court that the two accused persons, on March 20, conspired and killed Olaniyi, who was a mother of four children.

Oladoye also said that the offences were punishable under Sections 324 and 319 of the Criminal Code Cap 34 Volume 11, Laws of Osun 2003.

Magistrate Olalekan Ijiyode, who did not take the plea of the accused persons, said that the case was beyond the jurisdiction of his court.

He further said that the duplicate of the case file should be sent to the office of the Director of Public Prosecution for advice.

The magistrate adjourned the case till June 1, for further hearing.
