# Police kill 3 robbers in Apapa, Isolo

**T**HREE armed robbery suspects who allegedly operated at Apapa and Isolo areas of Lagos metropolis have met their waterloos at different points in the areas. The suspect at Apapa was caught in the cross fire between the police and the suspect when he was allegedly robbing a super market called shop Direct, along Randle road, Apapa. He was arrested when police men, on a distress call confronted him and his

colleagues. He allegedly died on his way to the hospital, following bullet injuries he sustained during the encounter.

Similarly two robbery suspects also died on their way to the hospital when the bullet of policemen from Isolo division hit them during exchange of fire at a robbing scene

Daily Champion gathered that the suspect at Apapa first engaged the policemen from the division in a gun duel, apparently to escape from being arrested.

An eye witness said the suspect had already commandeered shoppers at the place to lie face down or face death. He was said to have also commanded his boys to search all the victims. However luck ran against them when a passerby who witnessed the incident phoned the Divisional police Officer of Apapa Mr. Ari Mohammed.

Our witness who pleaded for anonymity said the DPO, led his men and tackled the suspect head on and shot him at the abdomen

Also in Isolo the suspects were alleged to have attacked passersby at a street in the area when police men got a distress call that the suspects were operating at the place. The police men led by the DPO Dan Koli stormed the place and engaged them in a shoot out, killing them.

Reacting to the incidents police public Relations Officer Mr. Frank Mba said locally made guns were recovered from the suspects. He said police men from State Criminal Investigation Department SCID Panti, Yaba have taken over the investigations
