FUEL SCARCITY! FG APOLOGISES TO NIGERIANS - NEWS



A man, who was said to be in his mid-30s, was on last Thursday in Lagos electrocuted when a high tension cable fell on him, according to the police.

Mr. Frank Mba, spokesman, Lagos State Police Command, told the *News Agency of Nigeria (NAN)* last Friday that the deceased, Haggi Kingsley was a resident of Badore Estate, Aja, on the Lekki/Epe expressway.

He said the corpse had been deposited at the mortuary for autopsy.

Mba said that the incident was being investigated by detectives from the State Criminal Investigation Department (SCID) Panti, Yaba.

In another development, two suspected robbers were last Thursday killed during a shoot-out with policemen in Aja.

Mba said the robbers were killed by a patrol team near Chevron Roundabout while operating on an unregistered motorcycle.

He disclosed that a revolver, two locally-made pistols, seven unexpended cartridges and three rounds of 9mm live ammunition were recovered from the robbers.
