

# 1 die in Lagos auto crash

A 39-year-old father of three, Joshua Oluwaniyi lost his life in Lagos last Saturday as a fast moving vehicle crushed him at a bus stop where he was waiting for a vehicle to convey him to his destination.

Four others who were also waiting for commercial vehicles at the same Ijaiye bus stop, in Ojokoro Local Development Council Area of the state, where the accident took place at about 1.00pm were also affected.

They sustained various degrees of injuries and now being treated at different private hospitals.

Besides, the killer tipper marked Lagos XR 847 GGE, two other commercial buses an 18-passenger and a faragon with registration numbers XG 961 AGL and XS 960 LSR, respectively, were involved in the accident..

*Daily Champion*, however, gathered that the deceased was returning home near General bus stop from Ijaiye area, a few kilometres from where he went to see his elder brother who is a pastor when he met his untimely death.

It was learnt that the accident and late Joshua's spontaneous death occurred within 10 to 15 minutes he left his family to visit his elder brother.

Through his cell phone, an eyewitness told *Daily Champion* that his wife was contacted. "When she sighted the body of her husband on the ground where it laid, she rolled on the ground and cried uncontrollably shouting his name on top of her voice as if that would wake him up," said an eyewitness who does not want his name in print.

After some time, it was gathered, the body was removed by the policemen from Meiran Police Station.
