11, 1956. He attended United Missionary Church of Africa (UMCA) Primary School. Bachita, 1968-1973; Fatimo Community College, Ekan Meje, 1973-1977; Kwara State College of Technology, School of Basic Studies, Ilorin, 1978-1979; and the University of Ilorin, Ilorin, 1984-1987.

He also attended Nigerian Institute of Journalism, Ogba, Ikeja, Lagos, 1990-1991 where he did his Postgraduate Diploma in Journalism and later, The University of Ibadan, 2001-2002 for his Masters of Arts Degree in History.

He joined the service of The Sun Newspapers as pioneer night editor, 2002-2004 before joining the services of the National Open University of Nigeria's Public Relations Unit where he worked from 2004 until his death in the auto crash of April 1, 2010.
