## 5 slain in Akure bank raid

No fewer than five people were reportedly killed in a bank robbery that occurred in Akure, the Ondo State capital, yesterday. Seven people sustained injute the incident which happened around 10.00 am threw the entire community into pandemonium as motorists and pedestrians ran for their lives. It force be attacked by the robbers. Two old generation banks (names withheld) were raided.

Daily Champion learnt the robbers shot sporadically to gain entry into the banking halls of the two banks. Two of them were ladies who on getting to adjoining streets to prevent likely reaction of the police.

The bullet-proof security doors of the two banks were blown down by the robbers with dynamite before they gained entry into the banking halls. Residence around the Oja Oba Market area of the town were in panic with people running helter skelter for their lives.

One of those killed was a middle aged woman said to have withdrawn some money from the bank with her <u>child</u> strapped on her back. She was reported. The arrival of security operatives was rejected by the people, who threw stones at the vehicles brought by police because they arrived late at the scene of State Command, Aremu Adeniran, however, said only two people were killed during the operation, adding that men of the command were already on the Meanwhile, the Ondo State Government which described the incident as unfortunate and sad, said the state which had been enjoying peace since the haven for robbers.

A statement by the Chief Press Secretary to the governor, Mr. Kolawole Olabisi, disclosed that while the state government was deeply sad about th attacks. It warned that government would, however, not fold its arms and watch the state turn into an operating ground for hoodlums.
