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**Nigeria: Two Die in Jos Fresh Attack**

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Jos — Two persons were feared dead after an attack by yet to be identified killers at the Federal School of Soil Conservation, Kuru, near Jos.

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The incident took in the morning, leaving few people injured.

They were rushed to the Vom Christian Hospital, VCH, a few kilometres from the scene of attack where they are receiving treatment.

Sources at the scene of the incident confirmed that the attack was carried out by Fulani herdsmen.

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It would be recalled that about a month ago, the School came under similar attacks where three people lost their lives including the school's chief security officer, with a number of livestock rustled in the process.

According to reports, youths of the area around K/Vom and Kuru are said to be on the heels of the killers suspected to be Fulani herdsmen. Also, the Police Mobile Force are said to be on the trail of the killers too but there are no available confirmation as to any arrest yet.

When our correspondent called the state Commissioner of Police, Alhaji ABdulrahman Akano, a voice from his line said he was in a state security meeting at the government's house.

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Similarly, the Command's Public Relations Officer, PPRO, Mr. Apev Jacob, said he was in a meeting, even as he could neither confirm nor deny the attack.

Majority of residents of the state are apprehensive about their safety during the forth-coming nation-wide elections, in view of incessant attacks which have continued in some parts of the state unabated.

However, the Commander of the Special Task Force, STF, Brig. Gen. Hassan Umaru had in

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an interview, urged the people to remain calm as everything was being done to ensure safety of lives and property during and after the elections.

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
