A 21-year old man, Muri Akeju, was yesterday stabbed to death in a gang fight **CRIME BEAT** after which his corpse was abandoned at the gate of May Hospital Limited, Sadiku Street, Ilasamaja, Lagos. PEOPLE & POWER

However, the step mother of the deceased, Mrs. Adenike Akeju said she got a call from one of the friend of the deceased that her step son had been killed in a

Mrs. Akeju told Saturday Champion that from the information she got from the President Goodluck Jonathan may have directed the Senate caller, it appeared her step son was killed by his friends

She said that the late Akeju though a school drop out was learning a trade on electrical appliances when he was alive.

She said prior to his death, the deceased has been away from home in the last two days

Mrs. Akeju further stated that the Ogun State-born electrical apprentice was the only child of his mother, Kemi, whom she said had long been separated from the deceased father.

She said the deceased had been under her care and the father for the past eight years since his mother walked out of the marriage.

Contrary to Mrs. Akeju�s narration that the boy had been away from home in the last two days, the father of the deceased, Mr. Wale Akeju, said his son was with him the morning before the incident. He said his son has been waiting to gain admission into one of nation s universities. Mr. Akeju upon arrival at the New Comments Olosan Police Station Mushin, sighted the corpse of his son in a motorcade and Cartoons after examining the corpse told Saturday Champion that the police must provide the killers of his son.

Akeju said he got the shock of his life when he received the news of the death of his son as he was with his son before he left for work on the fateful day only to CAMPAIGN President Goodluck Jonathan (m) be told few hours later that his son had been killed by yet an unidentified group of

The management of May Clinics Limited where the body of the late Akeju was first deposited before taken to Olosan Police Station, however, declined to comment on the issue. One of the staff who spoke on the condition of anonymity said the late Akeju was brought to the hospital dead and dropped at the entrance gate by yet an unidentified group of boys.

Confirming the incident, the Divisional Police Officer in charge of Olosan Police Station, Chief Superintendent of Police (CSP), Obinna Ikeagwuonu said he got a distress call from one of the doctors on duty at May Clinics that somebody was brought dead to the hospital.

CSP Ikeagwuonu said though he was attending an official meeting ordered his men to immediately swing into action which led to collection of the corpse from
