According to him, upon completion of investigation, the police will charge the suspect to court for criminal conspiracy, house trespass, kidnapping, rape and attempt to commit offence to wit culpable homicide.

In a related development, the police confirmed the death of three armed robbers who were burnt to ashes by angry villagers in Muchalla village in Mubi North Local Government of the state.

The police commissioner said investigation had led to the discovery of the killed robbers' enclave where two single barrel guns with 31 cartridges were recovered.

Among other recovered items, he said, were one lar riffle with

20 rounds of life ammunition, 17 pairs of wrappers, one Dane gun, 10 handsets, 224 cows and 25 sheep and three goats.

Shinaba said as at May 14, 2011 the police intercepted and recovered four AK 47 riffles, 234 rounds of life ammunition and 13 magazines from two people who made a u-turn on a motorcycle after spotting the police who were on the highway for stop and check.

He noted that the police have equally made a couple of arrests during the election period and most were charged to court for prosecutions.
