Benin — IT was a gory sight at No. 20 Evboka Street at Ahor Village in Uhunmwonde local government area of Edo state located on the lonely Benin-Lagos Bypass as a lifeless body of a 62-year old woman Felicia Agbonyinma was yesterday recovered from a disused dry well.

Daily Champion gathered that the deceased was found naked, with her mouth and eyes gagged without any wounds on her body, in a dry well located behind the same house where the villagers had a social wake over the weekend.

He said "when we did not see her we telephone the village and people began to search for her; then after sometime they saw a well and looked and saw a person inside-it was my mother"

Jolly said initially villagers who felt it was an abomination to find an aged woman in a well did not want to retrieve the corpse until men from the Ehor Police station showed up and youths in the area assisted in bringing out the corpse, which has since been deposited in a aprivate mortuary in Benin City.

Meanwhile the Edo state Police Public relations Commissioner ASP Peter Ogboi could not be reached for comments to confirm the incident as his cell phone was unreachable.
