3 dead, 6 injured in auto crash in Minna

HE Sector Commander FederalRoad Safety Commission (FRSC) in Minna, Mr. Tuma-S. Dalok has confirmed three persons dead and six injured in an accident at Pago village near Paiko in Minna Niger State.

He stated this yesterday in an interview with Champion, saying the accident occurred as a result of over speeding, trying to over take dangerously which is common with untrained

driver who don't have cost for life.

Mr. Dalok explained that a Mazda bus (353) with registration number AG188NBS going to Suleja had head on collision with one red Honda Accord with registration number AP210SUN coming to Minna from Paiko.

Sector Commander said the body of the three people that died has been deposited at the mortuary General Hospital.

Minna while six injured were receiving treatment at the hospital.

He however attributed most of the road mishaps to lack of trained drivers and urged all the motorists, drivers to respect the sanctity of life by driving carefully and avoid premature death.

Champion investigation revealed that the woman driving the Honda Accord name withheld was going to El-Amin International School Minna to pick her child and was overtaking before the accident.
