Tradegy as family of 3 perish in Onitsha

TRAGEDY struck yesterday morning at 3-3 area of Onitsha, the Anambra State commercial nerve centre, when a family of three including the father, mother and a child lost their lives in a fatal road accident.

According to sources, the father was carrying the members of the family on a motor-bike heading towards, down town Onitsha city when a commercial bus also heading to Onitsha rammed into them from behind at about 8am.

Daily Champion however

learnt that one of the two-kids of the family who was sitting on the tank of the bike but with serious child was rushed to a range of hospital.

road in several hours with many Onitsha bound traders streaded.
The state Police Spokesman, Mr. Emeka Chukwuemeka, an Assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP), when contacted

said he was not aware of the accident.

Sympathizers who gathered at the scene of the accident

decried the increasing rate of auto crashes in the state in the past week which they blamed on deplorable nature of roads in the State and impatience on the part of road users.

They urged both the State
