Gunmen kill bridegroom at wedding ceremony

NKNOWN gunmen on Saturday in Maiduguri truck at the venue of the wedding ceremony of 30vear-old Maduga Borikmen and shot him dead.

The News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) reports that stray bullets also hit one person and injured two others on the occasion.

According to an eve pleaded who witness. anonymity, three assailants arrived at the scene in a golf car.

When they alighted from the car with AK47 riffles, they went straight to the bridegroom, opened fire on him and zoomed off.

Borikmen was a former councillor from Shehuri North under Lamisula ward in the state capital and currently the Chairman of Borno excouncillors forum.

The state spokesman of the Joint Task Force (JTF) Lt.-Col. Hassan Mohammed. the incident, confirmed saying that the body of the victim had been evacuated.

"The two dead bodies recovered from the scene have been deposited at the University of Maiduguri Teaching Hospital (UMTH), while those injured are receiving treatment in the medical centre," he added.
