Tragedy: Doctor, 4 others electrocuted in Oba**Published on 21 December 2011 with 0 comments**[\[Post a Comment\]](#)**ALPHONSUS NWEZE, Onitsha**

TRAGEDY struck in Anambra State as five persons including a medical doctor were reportedly electrocuted Monday at Oba, Idemili South Local Government Area of the state.

Daily Champion gathered that trouble started when the medical doctor, simply identified as Obianigwe, was packing into a new building.

He was said to have employed the services of an artisan to install his sign post at the building that was formerly occupied by Oba Community Bank.

Sources say that it was in the process of installing the sign post that a long ladder the artisan used in installing the sign post pulled down and the doctor, his nurse, a patient and a friend to the patient in a bid to save the life of the artisan, rushed immediately and grabbed the ladder.

Unfortunately for the rescuers, the ladder then leaned on a high-tension cable which immediately sparked off light and roasted alive the five of them.

They were rushed to Nnamdi Azikiwe University Teaching Hospital, NAUTH, Nnewi, where they were confirmed dead minutes after arrival.

Lamenting the untimely death of Doctor Obianigwe and others, the chairman of Oba Youth Association, Mr. Dozie Nweke Ochiagha said that the doctor was packing to Oba, his community from Nnewi where he worked at NAUTH to help his people.

His words, "he was a specialist at NAUTH. He brought the hospital to Oba to help the people and others within the environs. The doctor and one other person that died hailed from Oba, so we have lost two persons in the electrocution".

When contacted, the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Mr. Emeka Chukwuemeka said that he can't comment on the matter as he is away on a course.

Efforts to get the commissioner of Police, Anambra State, Muktari Muhammed as pronounced failed as the number was unavailable.
