No fewer than eight prominent Deltans have been kidnapped in the last three weeks and released after a heart-breaking ransoms, ranging from N30million to N50 million, were allegedly paid.

Six heavily-armed gunmen, according to report at about

Six heavily-armed gunmen, according to report, at about 7pm stormed the DESOPADEC chief's wife's office – Allen Eye Clinic, located at the popular Lion's Building, along Nnebisi road, the nerve centre of Asaba, yesterday, fired several shots to scare their perceived enemies before she was driven away in her Range Rover Jeep (Sports).

The kidnappers later abandoned the vehicle few metres away from the Asaba International Airport, before they sandwiched her in their waiting Toyota Camry car and zoomed off.

Family source said few hours later, the kidnappers contacted the family, demanding a N50 million ransom. The victim's husband has, however, described the incident as "a tragedy, a set back and unfortunate", particularly when the state Governor at a stakeholders' meeting recently assured Deltans that his administration was determined to check the rising crime wave in the state. The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPPRO), Charles Muka, a Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP), however, said the command has launched a full-scale manhunt for the perpetrators.
