Woman, 25, docked for allegedly killing neighbour in fight over water

A 25-year-old woman was arraigned in Lagos on Friday for allegedly killing her neighbour following a fight while they were fetching water.

Alice Atubu, who resides at No 18, Michael Oladele St., Odogunyan, Ikorodu, is facing a two-count charge of conspiracy and unlawful killing before an Ebute Meta Magistrates' Court.

The prosecutor, Cpl. Onaiwu Iyobosa, told the court that the defendant was on October 21 involved in a quarrel with the deceased, one Rebecca Simeon (25), while they were fetching water.

According to the prosecutor, the defendant allegedly hit the victim with her fist in the stomach, resulting in her death.

Iyobosa said that the alleged offences contravene Sections 221 and 231 of the Criminal Code, Laws of Lagos State, 2011.

The defendant's plea was not taken by Magistrate Oluwakemi Doja-Ojo who ordered that the defendant be remanded in Ikoyi prison pending advice from the Director of Public Prosecution.

She adjourned the case to December 21 for mention.

2 robbery suspects killed by mob in Imo - Police

THE Police in Owerri on Friday said a mob killed two suspected members of a four-man robbery gang, believed to have been terrorising residents of Spibat area of Akwakuma, Owerri.

The Public Relations Officer of the state Police Command, Mr Vitalis Onugu, told the *News Agency of Nigeria (NAN)* that the suspects were arrested by members of the Special Anti-Robbery squad at the state Criminal Investigation Department (CID) who responded to a distress call.

He said the two suspects were first arrested by the local vigilance group operating in Spibat area in Akwakuma and

about to be lynched by the mob when the police arrived at the scene and rescued them.

"Responding to the call, the anti robbery squad got there and found the suspects already tied down with tyres around their necks and were about to be burned alive.

"They were rescued but at the point of death as a result of machete cuts dealt on them by the angry mob. They died before we could get them to the hospital.

"However, one of the suspects, Buchi, from Akpodim in Mbaise, Imo, managed to describe to the policemen the location of their hideout before he died," he said.
