Land dispute claims one life in Enugu

THE Enugu state command of the Nigeria police have commenced investigations into the alleged killing of one Ejike Onah in Nsukka.

The victim was allegedly attacked in his house on 3rd February by yet-to-be identified persons over an alleged incident of destruction of some parts of one Ndubuisi Ugwu's house at Agbani, Nguru, Nsukka as a result of land dispute.

He was allegedly given several matchet cuts which subjected the victim to an unconscious state and was rushed to St. Micheal's Hospital at Nsukka for resuscitation where he eventually died the following day.

The body has been deposited at the Bishop Shanaham Hospital Mortuary for autopsy.
