20 feared dead

Sunday. Several others injured in

the crisis are currently receiving treatment at the Federal Medical Centre in Jalingo. The crisis was said to

have erupted when the sup-porters of the former deputy chairman of he council Alhaji Lawal Audo Lau allegedly

prevented the care-taker chairman of the council, Mr. Yunana Kinkan from assuming

office. Lovalists of Kinkan were said to have resisted the move, leading to the eruption of violence in which dang-

erous weapons were used. The public relations officer of the Taraba state police

command, Mr. Firaii Ataii who confirmed the incident to journalists, however denied any loss of lives in the crisis. He said the police were still investigating the crisis, adding that no arrest has been made yet.

When Daily Trust visited the federal medical centre in Jalingo many of the those wounded in the crisis were seen on their sick beds rece-

iving treatment. Meanwhile, the state deputy governor, Arimiyau Dauda Abubakar has visited

Lau and appealed for calm. describing the crisis as unfortunate.
