

**T**wo armed robbers were yesterday shot dead in Kaduna by police patrol team.

Commissioner of Police Kaduna State Police Command, Ernest Ihaze told newsmen in Kaduna that the two men were part of a 20-men robbery gang that laid siege on the Jos Road by Ogbomosho Road, in the early hours of the day.

"Early this morning (Monday) at about 4:00 am, there was a distress call at Magajin Gari within Kaduna metropolis that hoodlums were attacking, harassing and stealing from the inhabitants of the area. Police patrol team responded immediately and exchange of gunfire ensued during which two of the

hoodlums were shot dead.

"Several items were recovered from them among which are one locally made pistol, one LG DVD machine, one Samsung VCD machine, one Akira VCD machine, one amplifier, as well as three remote controllers. A Mitsubishi L300 bus with registration number Gombe XB 263 AKK which was used for the operation was also recovered by the police."

Ihaze added that one Mohammed Abdullahi of Kabala Doki was also arrested yesterday morning at the Shehu Abubakar Gumi Central Market with arms and ammunition which are used

only by the police.

"One Mohammed Abdullahi was intercepted at the Shehu Abubakar Gumi Central Market with a concealed long range smooth rifle, three magazine of ammunitions, two live ammunitions, four blank ammunitions and one rubber bullets."

He, however, craved for the support and cooperation of the community to ensure that other hoodlums are routed out of the state adding that there was nothing the police can do without the support of the people.
