wo students of the Lagos-State Univer sity (LASU), Ojo and the Lagos state Polytechnic, Isolo were at the weekend killed by persons suspected to be secret cult members. The death of the students, Daily Trust learnt, is being investigated by detectives from the state's Criminal Investigation Department (SCID), Panti.

The LASU student identified as Ibukun, wasallegedly attacked on Thursday by three unknown young men on his way to church.

The late student who was said to be in the company of a female student going for a service at the Redeemed Church located on 23 Road, Festac town, when his killers attacked him.

Armed with axes and guns, the yet to be identified

attackers were said to have inflicted deep cuts on Ibukun and his female companion. Ibukun was said to have been taken to a nearby private hospital where he was confirmed dead.

In another cult related killing, a part-time student of the Lagos State Polytechnic, Isolo, was killed by suspected cultists.

Lagos state police spokesman, Mr Olubode Ojajuni, who confirmed the death of the two students, identified the murdered polytechnic student as Idowu Owojuni, a part two accountancy student.

Ojajuni said the late Owojuni was killed at Awori College, Ojo. According to him, one suspect has since been arrested in connection with the murder of Owojuni.

He said the suspect, Rilwan, was arrested with a locally made pistol and is said to have confessed to the murder.
