Another female corpse found at Ado

Barely four days after the corpse of a female school teacher was found on the football pitch of Ado primary school in Nasarawa State, another female corpse was seen last Tuesday morning, inside a bush, close to the entrance of the Abuja Gas Company, Ado.

Like the former corpse, the pant of the victim had been removed and was lying by the side of the body with a jeans trouser. Blood was also sighted at the nose and

mouth of the deceased, who carried no identity card and could not be identified by people around the area.

The police at New Nyanya were said to have picked up the body and taken it to their station.

When *City News* reporter visited the station, a reliable police source said that the police was informed about the corpse by somebody that

resides in 'one man' village. "The man informed us that he sighted people gathered close to the Gas Company and went to observe before alerting us," the officer said.

He said the police dashed down to the scene of the incident and met a large crowd looking at the corpse. "All we know about the victim is that she must have been in her mid thirties, light in complexion, four feet tall without tribal marks," he said.

The police source stated

further that he suspects that the girl must have been killed somewhere else and dumped close to the Gas company either in the wee hours of the morning or at night. "There is no sign of strangulation or a blow to the head of the victim and we are yet to conduct a postmortem on the corpse," he disclosed.

City News learnt that the police at New Nyanya are presently in a dilemma as to what to do with the body as all the mortuaries visited refused to

accept the corpse. "The mortuaries we took the corpse to all said they were filled. Even the Asokoro and Maitama General Hospital mortuaries refused to accept the body," the police officer said.

The source added that the police are searching for an alternative mortuary to take the body to.

The reporter sighted the body lying at the back of a police van in the Nyanya police station on Wednesday.

It would be recalled that

the corpse of a female primary school teacher, Mrs. Lydia Dogara was found last Saturday at the Ado primary school football pitch.

The late teacher was said to have left her house on Friday night for an all night vigil at a church close to the primary school.

A police source disclosed that the victim appeared to have been strangled as a head tie was on the neck of the deceased, with her hands as well as legs badly bruised.
