through the use of teargas, according to the investigation by *Daily Trust*, the police officer hurriedly took a riffle and quickly fired two shots in the head of his victim, and instantly killing the

As a result of the killing,

the whole town of Kaura Namoda broke into violence as people, both young and old, besieged the police station hunting for the ASP, who had disappeared. This, according to our

correspondent, who was in Kaura-Namoda town, angered the whole residents of the town, who subsequently took to streets and started burning all that they came across, including government buildings and some movable objects.

The police commissioner

of the state, Alhaji Saleh Abubakar Ningi, who visited the devastated scenes, told Daily Trust, that what the happened was "very unfortunate".

Alhaji Ningi also stated

that he was shocked to hear the news that a police officer has taken the law into his hands, "because this is against the rules and regulations of the police", he emphasized.

The police boss further

disclosed that it is only under the force order of 237 that a police is allowed to use gun, and not a situation like this, which can easily be settled through the use of teargas. He described the officer as

inexperienced and unprofessional who only joined the service by opportunity to destroy the image of the police. He said the police will not allow it to happen again", he added.

Ningi who spoke through his public relation officer, ASP Lawal Abdullahi, explained that he ordered the CID to take over the investigation, "because this is a criminal offence and culpable homicide punishable by death".
