

ANPP claims two supporters killed in Bauchi

Two people killed at the People's Democratic Party (PDP) presidential launch in Bauchi last week were All Nigeria People's Party (ANPP) members, the party claimed.

ANPP said Thursday in Abuja that its leadership condemned the killing of two of its members and the razing of its office in Bauchi.

The two people were reported to have been killed in violent clashes outside the PDP presidential launch between the supporters of the two parties.

In a statement signed by the party's director of publicity, Ibrahim Modibbo after an emergency meeting, the party described the attack as unprovoked and lacking in political decency.

It also quoted the national chairman of the party, Chief Edwin Ume-Ezeoke saying, "The law enforcement agencies and especially the Nigerian police must bring the culprits to book."

The party also alleged that it was its popularity that is making the PDP controlled

government very desperate and apprehensive of losing the state.

"ANPP warns that if such attacks continue, it would

respond accordingly as no single party has the monopoly of violence," the statement said.

The party also warns against the removal of its flags, campaign posters and

bill boards in Bauchi by miscreants and area boys sent by the state government would be resisted, saying the party's supporters cannot be mowed like chickens by reckless thugs.
