

Police kill four suspected armed robbers

FCT Commissioner of police, Lawrence Alobi has announced the killing of four suspected armed robbers.

Alobi said the suspected armed robbers were killed in the early hours of Monday after exchanging fire with the command's anti-robbery squad.

He told the News Agency of Nigeria in Abuja yesterday that the suspects were killed in two different instances.

Alobi said three of the suspects were killed at Dobi-Izon road off Gwagwalada-Abaji express way.

"The five-man gang blocked the road and terror-

ised innocent citizens, and our Rapid Response Team moved to the scene where three of the suspects were killed," he said.

Alobi said two others escaped with bullet wounds, while their vehicle, a Toyota Corolla with registration No. AA 36 YAB was recovered.

He said the other suspect was killed during a shoot out with police at Gwarimpa while five others escaped.

The police commissioner said exhibits recovered from the suspects include one locally made pistol, 21 live cartridges, some packets of Indian hemp and GSM hand set. He said those who escaped were being trailed by the police. (NAN).
